
Thanksgiving Talent Show

Over the 17 years that I have been at our school, I have seen the Library's Collection grow from 2,000 volumes to as high as 9,000. (Currently, we have 7,100 cataloged books, having removed the dated and long unborrowed.) Initially we built the Collection through federal funds, available through LAUSD, and through parental donations of cash and used books. Over time, as

I became more attuned to our students' reading interests, we have relied on family purchases of new books; for we have no budget for what has become my Library From that personal ministry. perspective, I seek to serve and be responsive, as much as I am financially able. And, I especially welcome book age-appropriate purchasing suggestions from students and teachers, thus building a Collection for the diverse interests and current needs of our learning community.


