However, having watched the recent Super Bowl, I was reminded of a musical contribution that speaks to the struggles for freedom, the singing of "Lift Every Voice and Sing." Its creation in 1900, and its inspiration over generations is addressed in a children's book, "Sing a Song" by Kelly Lyons.
