CHANGE TO OUR MASS SCHEDULE

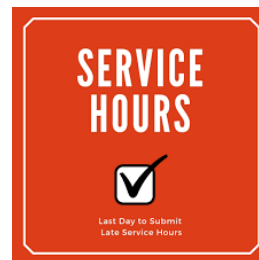


MASS IS NOW EVERY MONDAY AT 8:00AM

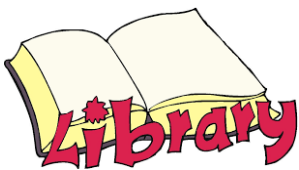
