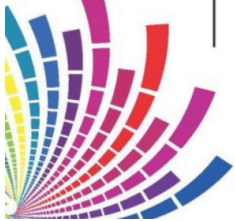

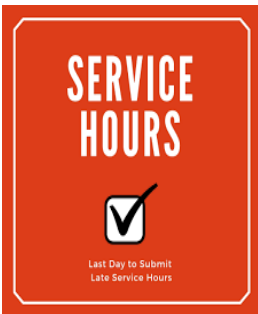

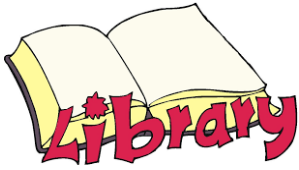
Support our 8th graders as they are selling
