As the end of another school year nears, I find myself reflecting on my journey of 17 years as your School Librarian. This volunteer voyage began as a parent, newly retired as a College Dean, meeting his service obligation by distributing hot lunches. Soon after, discovered a locked, non-operational Library and requested (and accepted) the challenge of reviving this dormant educational enterprise. Aided by a student's family member, we bid adieu to the old card catalog, removed outdated volumes, and identified 2,000 volumes for entry on a personally purchased laptop. Looking back on those early days, the phrase "it takes a village" comes to mind, as families helped build the collection by volunteering cash and book donations. This mission-related communal support gratefully continues as an ongoing theme, one that helps us respond to the current reading interests of our students and the needs of our faculty.
