### May the 4th be with You!



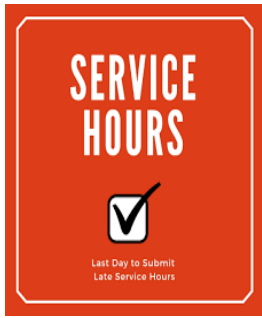

## 8th GRADE SALES

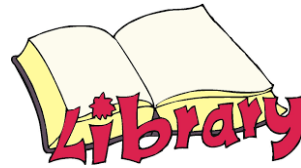
Support our 8th graders as they are selling
