



Our start of the school year is just around the corner. I hope that you have had a fun and relaxing summer. I am so excited to see all of you on our first day of school on **Wednesday**,

August 24th. Our first day of school will look like this.

7:00-7:30 Morning Care

7:30-8:00 Arrival. We will have a backdrop for 1st day pictures.

All parents, please park by the basketball courts. Students will line up by grade level on the blacktop by the lunch benches.

We will begin school with an outside assembly including: prayer, Pledge of Allegiance and 1st day pictures.

2nd day of school will be regular drop off following the cones and adult instructions, with the exception of TK/K whose parents may park on the basketball courts and walk them to Ms. Cruz to the TK/K classroom.

COVID-19 Guidelines & Protocols

We strongly believe that for students to reach their full academic, social-emotional, and creative potential, daily face-to-face interaction with teachers and peers together, on campus, is the optimal learning environment. Masking Requirements

Physical Distancing

Additional Measures

- Washing/Sanitizing hands and disinfecting high-touchpoint areas
- Improved ventilation by maintaining open doors and windows, and use of air purifiers.
- Please no supply sharing. Be sure that students have their own supplies.
- Drinking fountains will continue to be limited to the water bottle fill station. Please ensure that your child is bringing their own refillable water bottle to school daily.
